It is permitted max 15 devices containing lithium batteries and 2 lithium powerbanks per passenger with a max of 100 Wh each. \*This limitation can be exceeded with the operators approval. Protect always the powerbanks in order to prevent malfunctions. Isolate each powerbank in a plastic bag, protective bag or the original packaging. Do not carry any powerbank inside the checked-in luggage. If possible, carry your lithium battery devices inside the hand luggage. The spare batteries cannot be stored in the upper head compartments. Do not move your seat if any lithium battery device has slipped or is trapped inside the seat structure. Call the Cabin Crew for help. Damaged batteries are prohibited. If the lithium device heats up, changes its form or starts malfunctioning, alert the cabin crew.
