It is anticipated that more than 100 teams with over 1800 athletes will take part at PAUC in the following six (6) divisions: Open, Women's, Mixed, Master Open, Master Women's and master Mixed. Any player who is fourteen (14) years or older will be eligible to play at PAUC. The minimum age limit for athletes playing in the Master's divisions of PAUC is thirty (30) for for female players and thirty-three (33) for male players in the Master Open, Master Women's and Master Mixed divisions.

We are thrilled to host this event once again and are eager to offer you a fresh and memorable experience in our beautiful country. We look forward to showcasing Punta Cana and celebrating with you both on and off the field.

Tournament Overview

Location

PAUC will be held at one (1) official venue in the beach town of Cap Cana which is 10 minutes from the town of Punta Cana, Dominican Republic. Punta Cana is also the name of the City where Bavaro, Cap Cana and Punta Cana are all located.

The Dominican Republic, is a naturally wondrous place and the home of the city destination Cap Cana. The Dominican Republic, a spectacular island, is nestled between the islands of Cuba and Puerto Rico in the heart of the Caribbean, and only 670 miles southeast of Florida. Discover our island, Our culture, Our traditions, Our Beautiful Landscapes.

Dive into the ecological wonders of our land. Walk among the trails and open your eyes to a garden of tropical flora bursting with colors and filling the air with the aroma of the Caribbean. Explore this living tapestry arranged for your delight.

Visit one of our many our natural springs, "Hoyo Azul" located at end of a beautiful nature walk, and entertain yourself counting butterflies en route to the "Iguabonita" or Discover the mystic and breathtaking cenote "Las Ondas". Discover the many calcite crystal formations found inside these limestone caves. The destination city of Cap Cana has the goal to preserve its beautiful natural environment.

There will be plenty of things to do for all age ranges. This event is definitely one to bring the whole family to.

Climate

Average Weather in December in Cap Cana Dominican Republic:

Daily high temperatures are around 94°F/30C, rarely falling below 86°F/28C or exceeding 95°F/37C.

Daily low temperatures are around 78°F/23C, rarely falling below 75°F/20C On occasions the wind can be strong in December in Cap Cana.

Prepare for the possibility to play Ultimate in all conditions.



Tournament Overview

Event Dates

The Opening Ceremony and first games will take place on Monday 1st December with the tournament running through until Saturday 6th December. The Captains' and Coaches Meeting and the Spirit Captains' meetings will both take place prior to the Opening Ceremony.

Attendance at the Captains' and Coaches Meeting and the Spirit Captains' meetings by at least one (1) representative for each team is required. A limit of two (2) representatives per team will be enforced due to space restrictions. Times for the Meetings, Opening Ceremony and Opening Game will be advised at a later time. WFDF expects each team (in uniform) to participate in the Opening Ceremony on Day 1 and all teams should be prepared to play that day. Please play your travel accordingly.

Some finals will be played on Friday December 5th and some on Saturday December 6th with Closing Ceremony taking place immediately after the finals. All medal ceremonies will follow immediately after each final. Should weather cause delays to play, the schedule will be adjusted accordingly to ensure the finals are played as scheduled or prior. In severe weather the schedule or format might be adjusted with reduced games.



Teams and Divisions

All PAUC member National Federations who are in good standing are invited to participate at PAUC 2025 in Punta Cana in the following divisions: Open, Women's, Mixed, Master Open, Master Women's & Master Mixed. *Grand Master divisions will run if enough interest received.

Eligibility

- PAUC is an event for National and Club Teams. Team Roster Composition must meet the
 eligibility requirements as listed in Appendix D of the Rules of Ultimate 2021-2024 Appendix
 V3.
- All players on Team Rosters must be members of the National Federation in good standing, and must meet whatever other requirements are placed on them by the National Federation.
- Divisions (Open, Women's, Mixed, Master Open, Master Women's and Master Mixed *)
- Age Eligibility:
 - Any player who is fourteen (14) years or older will be eligible to play at PAUC. The
 minimum age limit for athletes playing in the Master's divisions is thirty (30) for the
 female identifying players and thirty-three (33) for male identifying players. All players
 must be the minimum age limit per division by the end of the calendar year in which the
 tournament concludes.
- WFDF strives to protect transgender athletes and to recognize the importance of autonomy
 of gender identity in sport and has created clear guidelines with minimally invasive
 requirements for TUE submissions. The guidelines were developed by the Medical and AntiDoping Committee. PAUC will abide by timelines and requirements as outlined in the WFDF
 Transgender Athlete and Differences in Sex Development (DSD) Athlete Policy.

Teams & Divisions

- For a division to take place at PAUC, there must be registration from a minimum of six (6) teams from at least three (3) countries.
- A team must have a minimum of twelve (12) on its playing roster for the event. Teams must pay players fees for the minimum roster when the players fees are due for the team to be viable.
- A team in the Mixed division must have a minimum of six (6) female and six (6) male players on its roster.
- A team may have a maximum of twenty-six (26) players on its roster.
- Maximum and minimum limits do not apply to Non-playing Team Support (guests, coaches
 or other support staff) who may be registered with the team for the event.

Venue and Transportation

All games (including the Opening and Closing days) will be played at the Los Establos Polo Fields in Cap Cana. The Cap Cana Sports City includes 19 full-sized grass ultimate playing fields with their respective safety zones. The venue offers parking, restrooms, water, cafe and restaurants and multiple shaded areas to get out of the sun or rain between games. Los Establos is a privately owned fully fenced facility with two Polo fields with state of the art natural green level manicured lawns and a proven drainage system.





International Airport

We recommend you use the Punta Cana International Airport (PUJ) located 10 minutes from the fields as your inbound destination. Airport transfers to and from the official hotels are offered by the LOC on a pre-booked, prepaid basis. This airport offers a significant number of flights from multiple destinations daily.

Aeropuerto Internacional Las Americas located in the city of Santo Domingo which is approximately 2.5 hours drive. No airport transfers are offered from the LOC.

The LOC DO NOT recommend you use the following airports given their location to Cap Cana:

- Aeropuerto Internacional Del Cibao (Santiago)
- Puerto Plata International Airport (Puerto Plata)

Official Event Shuttles

Shuttle buses will ONLY transport teams who book and stay at the official PAUC hotels to the fields daily. Busses from all hotels have a maximum of 60 minutes and minimum of 30 minutes per trip.

All shuttles will get players to the fields no less than 60 minutes before the scheduled start time of the first game for each team. Return shuttles will leave just after the time cap of the last game your team plays each day. For games finishing on point and before the 100 minutes, you may have a little longer to wait. Detailed shuttle information will be provided when the schedule is firmed and after team and player registrations close.

Please note - if you book your own accommodations, you will not be permitted to use the Event Shuttle buses and must make your own arrangements at your own cost.

Travel and Visas

Travel Visa for PAUC 2025

You are responsible for obtaining the correct paperwork to visit the Dominican Republic to compete at PAUC 2025. Please note that we cannot provide specific advice on the process, but we do strongly recommend that you get started as soon as possible. WFDF can provide players with a letter confirming your participation as a player at the event after the players fees are paid and after the NF has supplied a roster endorsement letter with your name on it. Please make specific requests for such letter by filling out this online form.

Please Note:

- We cannot and will not provide a formal "invitation" to attend the event and non-ability to enter the Dominican Republic is not grounds for a request for a refund for a team and/or player fees.
- Please be aware that some nations do not require a visa, however you may have to travel with certain paperwork to show officers at the Dominican border - We recommend EVERY TEAM makes specific inquiries.
